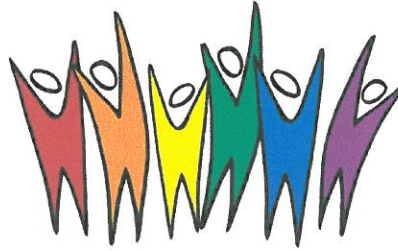


# Upcoming Faculty Workshops
